DOCUMENTATION. THE FOLLOWING RECOMMENDATIONS CONCLUDE THE REPORT: 1) REFUGEE-INITIATED INCOME-GENERATING PROJECTS WHICH ARE APPROPRIATE TO PAKISTAN'S DEVELOPMENT POLICIES SHOULD RECEIVE INTERNATIONAL AND LOCAL SUPPORT; 2) NEWLY-ARRIVED REFUGEES SHOULD BE GIVEN A HUNDRED PER CENT RELIEF WHILE AID TO THOSE SETTLED FOR MORE THAN TWO YEARS SHOULD BE PHASED OUT BY GRADUAL MONTHLY REDUCTIONS; 3) CAREFUL MONITORING OF THE PHASING OUT PROCESS MUST ENSURE THAT, AT EACH STEP, REFUGEE INCOME IS ADEQUATE; AND 4) REFUGEES SHOULD BE WELL-INFORMED ABOUT REASONS FOR, AND THE MODALITIES OF, THE PHASING OUT WITH A TRIAL PERIOD AT THE OUTSET.

PINPOINTING DISPARITIES WITH PRACTICAL SUGGESTIONS TOWARD IMPROVING POST-EVENT ADJUSTMENT FOR ALL. ARGUING FORCEFULLY FOR AN EGALITARIAN LENS IN HUMANITARIAN AID, THE BOOK OFFERS GUIDELINES THAT GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES AND NGOs ALIKE CAN IMPLEMENT AT ALL LEVELS OF PREVENTIVE AND RELIEF EFFORTS TO BETTER ASSIST VICTIMS AND MINIMIZE FURTHER TRAUMA. IT IS LAMENTABLE THAT SOME OTHER EUROPEAN NATIONS HAVE SO MANIFESTLY FAILED TO PULL THEIR WEIGHT IN THE SYRIAN REFUGEE CRISIS AND THE UK SHOULD DO MORE TO SECURE SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTIONS FROM OTHER LARGE EU NATIONS. THE OVERWHELMING EMPHASIS OF UK FUNDED HUMANITARIAN RELIEF SHOULD BE TO

HELP REFUGEES REMAIN IN THEIR OWN REGION, SO THAT THEY HAVE THE POTENTIAL TO RETURN HOME WHEN THIS BECOMES POSSIBLE. THE BULK OF HUMANITARIAN EFFORT IN THE REGION SHOULD SHIFT AWAY FROM A FOCUS ON REFUGEE CAMPS TO PROVIDING SUPPORT FOR THE MAJORITY OF SYRIAN REFUGEES WHO ARE CURRENTLY RESIDING IN TOWNS AND VILLAGES IN LEBANON OR JORDAN. THIS IS SOMETHING MANY DONORS REMAIN RELUCTANT TO DO; THE UK MUST LEAD THE WAY. TO THAT END THE DFID SHOULD USE NATIONAL PLANS AS THE BASIS FOR ITS ASSISTANCE TO LEBANON AND JORDAN, AS WELL AS LAUNCHING A MEDIUM-TERM DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME IN JORDAN. A CLEAR PRIORITY MUST BE GIVEN TO THE URGENT PROVISION OF EDUCATION FOR SYRIAN REFUGEE CHILDREN TO AVOID THE RISK OF A LOST GENERATION. THE COMMITTEE ALSO CALLS ON DFID TO BECOME FAR MORE TRANSPARENT ABOUT HOW MUCH CONTINGENCY FUNDING IT SETS ASIDE FOR RESPONSES TO NEW HUMANITARIAN CRISES GOING FORWARD.

2018-05-04 BUREAUCRATIZING THE GOOD SAMARITAN IS ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION OF REFUGEE RELIEF PROGRAMS. IT DESCRIBES THE PRACTICAL, POLITICAL, AND MORAL ASSUMPTIONS OF THE 'INTERNATIONAL REFUGEE RELIEF REGIME.' TONY WATERS EMPHASIZES THAT THE AGENCIES DELIVERING HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ARE EMBEDDED IN RATIONALIZED BUREAUCRACIES WHOSE VALUES ARE DETERMINED BY THEIR INSTITUTIONAL FRAMEWORKS. THE DEMAND FOR 'VICTIMS' IS OBSERVED IN THE CLOSE RELATION BETWEEN THE INTERESTS OF THE POPULAR PRESS AND THE DECISIONS MADE BY BUREAUCRACIES. THIS PRESENTS A PARADOX IN ALL HUMANITARIAN RELIEF ORGANIZATIONS, BUT PERHAPS NO MORE SO THAN IN THE RWANDA RELIEF OPERATIONS (1994-96) WHICH ENDED IN THE LARGEST MASS FORCED REPATRIATION SINCE THE END OF WORLD WAR II. THIS CRISIS IS ANALYZED WITH AN ASSUMPTION THAT THERE IS A BASIC CONTRADICTION BETWEEN THE DEMANDS OF THE BUREAUCRATIZED ORGANIZATION AND THE NEED OF RELIEF AGENCIES TO GENERATE THE EMOTIONAL PUBLICITY TO SUSTAIN THE INTEREST OF NORTHERN DONORS. THE BOOK CONCLUDES BY NOTING THAT IF REFUGEE RELIEF PROGRAMS ARE TO BECOME MORE EFFECTIVE, THE CONNECTION BETWEEN THE PRESS'S EMOTIONAL DEMANDS FOR 'VICTIMS' AND THE BUREAUCRATIC ORGANIZATIONS'S DECISION PROCESSES NEED TO BE IDENTIFIED AND REASSESSED.
